### Goal

The summer school aims to introduce interested students to the background, recent findings, and methods in researching into matter fluxes and the underlying biogeochemical processes of permafrost ecosystems.

# **Topics**

- Vegetation of permafrost regions:
  - Biomass analysis and organic matter storage
  - Vegetation types of permafrost regions
  - Vegetation shift
- Climate/hydrology of permafrost regions:
  - Climatic development in the Holocene and particularly the last 100 years
  - Precipitation pattern and riverine discharge
  - Taliks
  - Forms of permafrost degradation, including thermokarst
- Soils of permafrost regions:
  - Soil distribution of permafrost regions
  - Processes of soil formation, i.e., soil weathering and pedogenic mineral formation
  - Soil organic carbon storage
  - Gas exchange between soil and atmosphere
  - Dissolved matter (inorganic, organic) losses from permafrost soils
